

Since 2012, Nihon Institute of Medical Science (NIMS) has provided the annual Summer Program in Portland, Oregon for students. The purpose of the program is to give students opportunities to learn and understand history, culture and medical settings in foreign countries.

In 2019, 46 students applied to the program and were divided into 2 groups. Thirty students of the Department of Nursing and the Department of Radiological Technology visited Portland, Oregon. The other 16 students of the Department of Rehabilitation visited Seattle, Washington.

Pre-program Preparation

Before the program started, students attended preprogram preparation classes to learn English conversation, Medical English and gestures to develop their communication skills with foreign people.



Day 1 August 21, 2019

The program participants gathered at Narita Airport to leave for Portland and Seattle on 21st August. During the program, participants visited Portland stayed at Portland State University accommodation, and the others visited Seattle stayed at Washington University accommodation.



Day 2 August 22, 2019

Participants visited Meals on Wheels People, a lunch center, which is a non-profit organization providing meal delivery service for older adults in their community.



Seattle, Washington

Participants visited the Snoqualmie Falls and the Harbor View Medical Center. At the medical center, Dr. Koichiro Nandate, an anesthesiologist, gave NIMS students a lecture on the medical system and the medical business in U.S.



Day 3 August 23, 2019

Participants visited the Providence St. Vincent Medical Center and participated in a hospital training. Participants took part in a guided tour of the Boeing factory and then visited the Museum of Flight in Seattle.

Seattle, Washington

Students visited Bastyr University and attended a special lectures on human anatomy and herbal medicine by Dr. Masahiro Takakura, who is working for the MLB Seattle Mariners team as a medical practitioner.

Participants visited several sightseeing spots in the Central Oregon, the Mount Hood, the Trillium Lake and the Timberline Lodge, where they enjoyed majestic nature and views.
